Email received from Surfacing below:

As you will be aware, the site received structural patching to address underlying defects in the carriageway. A further phase of works, involving the application of micro asphalt, is scheduled for later in this financial year.

Micro asphalt is a specialist surface treatment designed to seal the carriageway, restore texture, and extend the life of the road. It provides a smoother running surface for vehicles while protecting against further deterioration.

In light of the concerns you have raised, we will arrange for a member of our team to attend and inspect the site as a priority to ensure it remains safe and serviceable until the next phase of works takes place. I am happy to provide an update to you once this inspection has taken place.

Thank you again for bringing this to our attention. We appreciate your patience and understanding while we work to complete these improvements.
